Together Toward Equity Fellowship

The Public Health Institute is launching the Together Toward Equity Fellowship to strengthen community leadership and organizational impact. The Fellowship will create a dynamic pathway to invest in our shared goal of an effective, sustainable and equity focused public health infrastructure for the future. What sets the Together Toward Equity Fellowship apart from other programs is our focus, investment, and commitment to community-based organizations and emerging leaders.

The Together Toward Equity Fellowship forges a pathway for Fellows to grow within and with community organizations through coaching, capacity building activities, access to subject matter experts, project-based leadership, and peer networking. To provide additional support and benefits to organizations, the Fellowship includes peer-engagement, skills-building, and organizational support for each organization represented in the Fellowship. This includes, but is not limited to, access to virtual trainings and online self-guided learning.

Fellows will:

- Receive coaching from experts in the field
- Attend three in-person convenings
- Advance a self-identified project that elevates their leadership skills
- Meet twice a month as a cohort learning together

Organizations will:

- Access capacity building opportunities
- Connect through peer-engagement
- Access virtual trainings
- Benefit from access to organizational support tools

Commitment

Together Toward Equity Leadership Fellows are expected to participate and engage in all virtual and in-person learning and growth opportunities, including meetings with the assigned coach. All in-person meetings will take place in California and may require an overnight stay. We anticipate Fellows dedicating 10–12 hours per month, on average, to growing their power and leadership potential. Fellows will work toward advancing a self-identified project that not only creates opportunities to apply learnings, demonstrates growth and directly impacts the organization, but most importantly, provides a benefit to their community of focus.

Monthly Meetings

- Two Tuesdays per month meet as a cohort for 90 minutes
- Group and individual Meetings with assigned coach

Together Toward Equity Leadership Fellows will receive a stipend of \$5,000 over the course of 12 months, in three installments. In addition to stipends, the Together Toward Equity Fellowship will cover all associated travel costs for the Fellows.
